

**NOTICE TO BIDDERS**  
**SONORA MUNICIPAL AIRPORT**  
**TxDOT CSJ 1207SONOR**

Sealed proposals for the construction of airport improvements at the Sonora Municipal Airport need to be addressed and delivered to Mr. Charles Graves, City Manager, 201 E. Main, Sonora, Texas 76950. Proposals will be received until 2:00 pm, August 21, 2012, then publicly opened and read. Any proposal received after closing time will be returned unopened.

In general, the work consists of repair apron pavement; airport drainage improvements; erosion and sedimentation controls; replace and relocate existing wind cone; install segmented circle; replace and relocate existing beacon and tower; relocate and replace fuel station; and install retaining g wall with game-proof fence.

Minimum wage rates have been predetermined as required by law and are set forth in the specifications.

Cashier's check, money order, or teller's check drawn by or on a state or national bank, a savings and loan association, or a state or federally chartered credit union (collectively referred to as "bank") in the amount of two percent (2%) of the total bid price stated in the proposal, made payable without recourse to TxDOT Aviation, Agent for the Owner or a bid bond in the same amount from a reliable corporate surety authorized to do business in the State of Texas and

acceptable to TxDOT Aviation, Agent for the Owner must accompany each proposal as a guarantee that the bidder, if successful, will enter into a contract, and make bond in accordance with the requirements of the specifications. TxDOT Aviation reserves the right to retain any check, bank money order or bank draft as liquidated damages in the event the bidder withdraws its bid after the proposals are opened and before official rejection of the bid by TxDOT Aviation/Owner, or, if successful in securing the award of the contract, the successful bidder fails to enter into the contract and fails to furnish satisfactory performance and payment bonds.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Bond and Payment Bond, each in the full amount of the contract price, executed by a surety company or surety companies authorized to execute surety bonds under and in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas.

The proposed contract is subject to the Vernon Texas Civil Statutes, Section 2161.061 concerning the participation of Historically Underutilized Business. HUB goal is set at **6%**.

The Owner/Agent reserves the right to reject any irregular proposal and the right to waive technicalities if such waiver is in the best interest of the Owner/Agent and conforms to State and local laws and ordinances pertaining to the letting of construction contracts.

The Owner/Agent, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively assure that minority enterprises are afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award.
